A WORD FROM OUR PRESIDENT, ALLEN BYNUM

OWMA continues to make a positive impact:

Each year I am more and more impressed with the generosity of our members and their desire to share their hunting opportunities with others. Board member Bill Hoffmann hosted a weekend veteran/legislator combination deer/hog hunt with Combat Marine Outdoors. I was able to attend the final dinner and listen to the stories of two active duty heroes who were both seriously injured and subsequently re-enlisted for more deployment. Impressive doesn't even begin to describe the Hoffmann Ranch or the gracious hosts. Combat Marine Outdoors is doing marvelous work with our soldiers and their troubles, many of whom suffer from severe PTSD. We plan to partner on more hunts with CMO and encourage each of you to consider hosting them if you are able. Board member Stan Kimbell once again donated a cow elk hunt on his ranch in southwest Oklahoma where new OWMA member, John Row, harvested a nice elk. Congrats John and thank you Stan!

So far, OWMA member Billy Howell and I have signed up to host a youth hunter with the Oklahoma Youth Hunting and Shooting Program Spring Turkey Hunt March 31- April 1. This is a great program that our own Board member Sam Munhollon is involved in. We will be taking first time hunters who otherwise would likely never get the opportunity to do so. We are currently finalizing language for the current legislative session. One significant area we are working on is matching the hunting/fishing without permission penalties to the trespassing penalty of \$500, up from \$50. We learned through OWMA member experiences that Game Wardens are most likely to write citations for the hunting/fishing without permission violations in lieu of trespassing. Other areas of interest include legislation dealing with: fence cutting, extending rifle season, clarification on trespass language and penalties, and a portion of fines going to the District Attorney's general fund.
